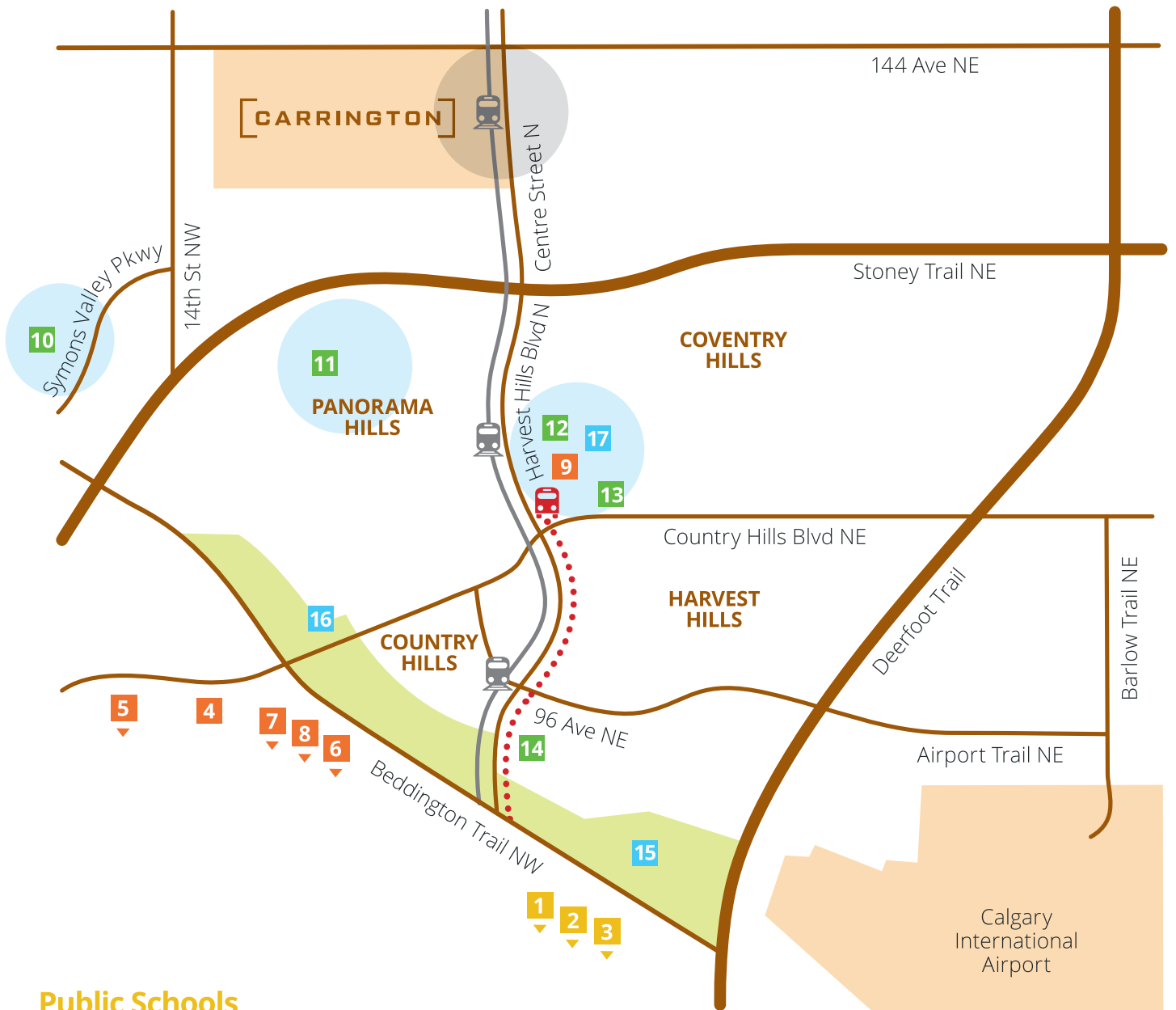
Accessibility
